

Animals

Except in the City's Equestrian Park, horses, cattle, and livestock of any kind are prohibited in any park. Domestic animals, i.e., dogs or cats, on a leash no more than six feet (6') in length and under the control of a person, may be brought into parks. It is unlawful for any person to hitch or fasten any animal to any tree, shrub, fountain, monument, lamppost, or any other ornament growing or situated in any public street, public park or place within the corporate limits of the City. It is unlawful for any person to allow any animal under his control to stand near enough to any such trees or shrubs to bite, rub against or otherwise injure same. No person shall annoy, interfere with, injure, release from confinement, or abandon any fowl, or animal, wild or domestic, in a City park or on a trail. No person shall, in any park, set a trap or snare, or shoot, injure, or poison any wild animal or bird, or injure or destroy any nest except as authorized by an animal regulatory officer.
