

Care of Parks and Park Facilities

In any park owned or operated by the City, it shall be unlawful to cut, break, move, take or otherwise injure, destroy or deface any trees, shrubs, plants, turf, rock or any building fence, bridge, sign or other structure, or pollute any spring or stream. No person shall dump any earth, rubbish, or other substance or material in or upon any park without written permission from the City. No person shall throw or deposit litter in any park within the City except in public receptacles and in such manner that the litter will be prevented from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any part of the park or upon any street or other public place. Where public receptacles are not provided, all such litter shall be carried away from the park by the persons responsible for its presence and properly disposed of elsewhere. All persons and groups reserving park facilities shall leave the park clean and in good repair. Persons violating this section may be barred from further reservation of the facilities, at the discretion of the City Council. It shall be unlawful to scratch, cut, injure or deface any of the buildings, fences, structures or other property or pollute any of the fountains, ponds or any other improvements; or to cut or injure flowers or flowerbeds within a park; to walk upon turf or seeded areas where posted; or for the owner of any dog to allow the same to run at large within the parks.
