


stamped set of plans returned to you for permit approval. If additional copies are needed you will need to contact the designer or original provider.

Gas line diagrams will no longer be required to be submitted at permit application. Rather the subcontractor will need to provide a gas clearance report on the site, preferably attached to the furnace for the gas line inspection and or 4-way inspection. Without this report a clearance will not be provided at time of inspection.

Design Standard for brick and stone- this shall be reflected on the both plans submitted for plan review. If you are short the amount required it will require a new set of plans to be drawn and new .pdf file submitted. Red lines are no longer going to be accepted at time of permit application. This ensures that the Engineer has verified all work and or changes to the plans at time of submittal. Any changes to plans after review shall be referred back to the office and additional fees will be assessed.
